

FIREWORKS

a) It shall be unlawful for any person to set off, use, burn, explode or fire any firecrackers, fireworks, torpedoes, bombs, rockets, pin wheels, fire balloons, Roman candles, toy cannons or any other fireworks of a like kind, except from 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. daily from, June 28, to July 6, any type or kind of fireworks or firecrackers within the corporate limits except as provided for subsection (b).

b) On July 4, the time proscribed for the use of firecrackers and fireworks shall be from 8 a.m. to 12 a.m. (midnight).

c) Any person who shall set off, use, burn, explode or fire any firecrackers, fireworks, torpedoes, bombs, rockets, pin wheels, fire balloons, Roman candles, toy cannons or any other fireworks of a like kind within the corporate limits of the City outside of the prescribed time limits in subsection (a) and (b), shall be deemed guilty of an offense; provided however, that this Section shall not apply to parks or other public places, when in charge of competent persons and under permit issued by order of the Board of Aldermen.

d) Any person guilty of an offense or in violation of this ordinance is punishable of a fine of no less than \$25 and up to \$500.
